

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- 1) Open to all residents within a 200 km radius of Uxbridge, Ontario.
- 2) All work must be designed and created by the entrant (no commercial kits or patterns) and completed after January 1<sup>st</sup>. 2007.
- 3) All media will be eligible.
- 4) There is a non-returnable jurying fee of \$20.00 per artist.
- 5) **Works will be juried by CD or emailed as a JPEG file.** Up to three pieces may be submitted, for consideration by the jury with up to 3 images for each work.  
**CD's will not be returned.** If these formats are not possible for you please contact us to discuss alternatives.
- 6) Each image must have the artist name, title, date of work and size of work in inches. A short artist statement (one sentence) on each piece must accompany the application.
- 7) Works chosen for the exhibition must be delivered on the dates specified below. Two-dimensional works should be ready to hang, mounted or frames, and with hanging wire. Please do not send large rolled drawings or paintings.
- 8) Works must be delivered by the artist or designate.  
**WORKS SENT VIA A DELIVERY SERVICE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**  
The Uxbridge Celebration of the Arts will insure the works on its premises from Sunday September 20 until Sunday September 27. Works will not be insured during transit.
- 9) The jurors reserve the right to disqualify any work which is misrepresented on the CD or JPEG file used in the jurying process.
- 10) The jury's decision is final. **NO ENTRY MAY BE WITHDRAWN ONCE IT HAS BEEN ACCEPTED.**
- 11) The artist grants the Uxbridge Celebration of the Arts the right to photograph accepted works for publicity, educational and reference purposes.

The Uxbridge Celebration of the Arts will retain a 20% commission on all sales.  
*Works are not required to be for sale.*

Artists whose work **HAS NOT** been selected into the exhibition will be notified by mail or email.

Artists whose work **HAS BEEN** selected into the exhibition will be notified by telephone by Tuesday, Sept 8.

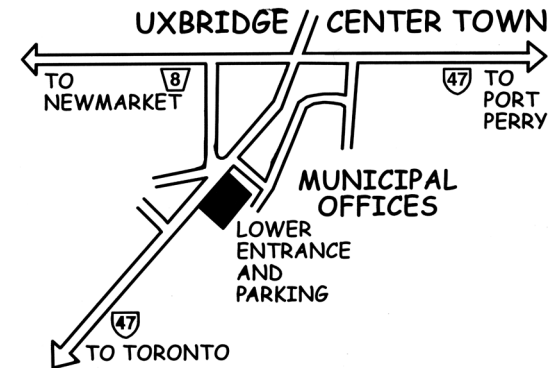
