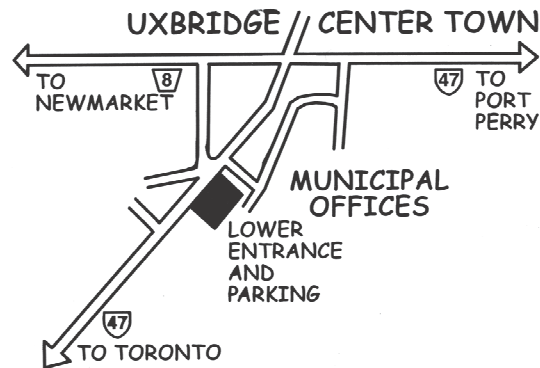

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY
PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Open to all residents within a 200km radius of Uxbridge, Ontario.

All work must be designed and created by the entrant (no commercial kits or patterns) and completed after January 1st, 2009.

All media will be eligible.

There is a non-refundable fee of \$20 per artist.

Works will be juried by CD or emailed JPEG file and must be received by the deadline of August 5, 2011. Up to three pieces may be submitted, with up to 3 images for each work. CD's will not be returned. If these formats are not possible, please contact us. Each image must have the artist name, title, date of work and size in inches. A short artist statement (one sentence) must accompany each piece.

Two-dimensional works should be ready to hang, mounted or framed, and with hanging wire. Do not send large rolled drawings or paintings.

Works must be delivered on the dates specified, by the artist or a designate. **Works sent via a delivery service will not be accepted.** The Uxbridge Celebration of the Arts (UCA) will insure all works in its possession from Sunday Sept. 18 until Sunday Sept. 25, 2011. Works will not be insured either during transit or after Sept. 25, 2011 and UCA will not be responsible for their safety during those times.

The jurors reserve the right to disqualify any work misrepresented on the submitted CD or JPEG file. In all matters, the jury's decision is final. No entry may be withdrawn once it has been accepted.

The artist grants the UCA the right to photograph accepted works for publicity, educational and reference purposes.

Cash awards are available for: Juror's Choice, Best Painting (includes drawing, collage etc), Best Sculpture, Best Photography and People's Choice (ballot).

Sale of Works:

The Uxbridge Celebration of the Arts will retain a 20% commission on all sales. Note that works are not required to be for sale. All works sold and all cheques must be payable to Uxbridge Celebration of the Arts.

Notification:

Artists whose work **HAS NOT** been selected will be notified by mail or email. Artists whose work **HAS** been selected will be notified by telephone by Tues. Sept. 6, 2011.
